AFFIDAVIT OF GEORGE ALMOND


I, George Almond being first duly sworn and under penalties of perjury, swear and state as follows:

1. On August 4, 2006, I was first arrested by Sgt. Watts and his crew.
2. I was familiar with Watts because on several prior occasions he and his crew had stopped me and attempted to get me to give them money.
3. On August 4, 2006, I had just been visiting a friend of mine, "Tricey," who lived on the 3rd Floor of the 574 E. Browning building. I was standing outside in front of the building talking with a few people I had run into that I was also friends with. I did not have any drugs on me.
4. At some point, I heard someone yell "clean up." I then noticed that the police, including Watts and multiple members of his team, all started arriving quickly in their unmarked cars from all directions.
5. The officers, including Officers Jones, Mohammed, Gonzalez, "Doug," "Chinaman," "Co-Co," "Smitty" and several others all exited their vehicles.
6. I went back into the building and up to the 3rd floor to the apartment of the friend I was visiting. I did this because I was familiar with Watts and his crew and knew that when they showed up they arrested everyone they found in the building. I also knew that they regularly planted drugs on people.
7. I stayed in the apartment with my friend for some time attempting to wait out Watts and his crew. After a while, Tricey and I decided to exit. As we did, we realized that Watts, Mohammed, Gonzalez, Al Jones, and several other officers were still in the hallway.

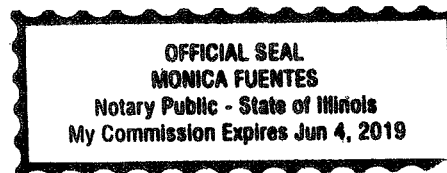
8. Watts saw us and ordered us to stop. The officers then searched both of us. Watts then ordered me into the stairwell of the hallway but he left Tricey in the hallway. Watts and Jones escorted me into the stairwell.
9. Once in the stairwell, Watts asked me if I had any money on me. I told him I only had a few dollars. Watts said that wasn't enough and that I was going to jail. I asked why and he said that they got some rocks and that they were my drugs. I knew he was setting me up.
10. At the station, Mohammed was writing up my report while I was handcuffed to a bench. Watts, Jones, and Doug were also in the room at the time. I asked Mohammed what I was being charged with. At some point one of them put drugs out on the table. Watts told me that they were going to charge me with possession and manufacturing.
11. I never reported this to OPS because I had heard that Watts retaliated against people who went to OPS.
12. I couldn't afford an attorney. I got a public defender. The public defender told me to take a plea deal. I served a year for this conviction.


